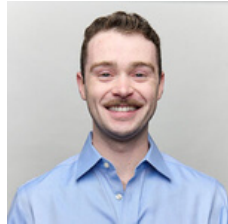

WPC KIDS ON SUNDAYS

NURSERY– INFANTS THROUGH K4

The nursery at Westminster encourages the physical, emotional, and spiritual growth of our youngest congregants. Each Sunday, nursery care for infants and children through K4 is available from 8:30–12:30. Nurseries are staffed with professional caregivers, assisted by parent volunteers. All those who work with children are required to have a background check and complete Child Protection Training. Parents can check in at the station in the hallway. All you need to bring is a diaper bag with essentials for your child.

SUNDAY SCHOOL– K5 THROUGH 5TH GRADE

Sunday School for Kindergarten through 5th grade meets in the 100 hall during the program year from 10:00–10:50. Parent volunteers lead classes using Shine Curriculum which explores the Bible and nurtures faith development through inquiry, discussion, games, crafts, and service learning projects.

WPC ON SUNDAYS

CHILDREN'S CHURCH

Children's Church is an age-appropriate worship education offering for children in Kindergarten through First Grade. Each Sunday during 11:15a worship, children join their families in the Sanctuary for "big Church." Following the Prayer of Confession and Gloria Patri, children are invited to join Children's Church, where worship is led by a pastor and parent volunteers. During Children's Church, children will engage in worship through songs, Bible stories, crafts and games. Parent volunteers supervise play in centers. Following worship, parents can pick up their children in the Children's Church Room (near the Library).

Parent volunteers can sign up on the website and are required to complete a background check and Child Protection Training.

FLEXIBLE SPACES FOR FAMILIES

While your family is engaged in the life of Westminster, we have a number of spaces to support your needs.

The Atrium outside the Sanctuary is for overflow seating for worship.

The Family Lounge on the 200 hall provides a livestream of the service, comfortable seating, pack-n-play, fridge, and changing station.

Worship bags are provided for children to engage in worship while having a sensory focus tool to explore. These bags are prepared by volunteers and contain reusable items. Please return them to the baskets each Sunday.

DURING THE YEAR

WWS CHAPEL

During the school year, Westminster Weekday School students meet for Chapel in the Sanctuary every other week. One of the pastors leads them in a time of worship including music, Bible stories, and prayer. Parents receive a newsletter about what children learned in chapel. Sample topics include creation, Abraham and Sarah, the Exodus, Jesus calls the disciples and more!

CHOIR

Choirs for children in 1st–5th grade meet on Wednesdays from 4:30–5:15. Parents can sign up on the church website or by emailing Marlon Hurst, Lynne Robinson or Hunter Smith. The Junior Choristers are directed by Lynne Robinson and Senior Choristers are directed by Hunter Smith.

Cherub choir is for children K4 and K5, providing opportunities for them to experience music and new sounds. Cherubs meet on Wednesdays in Room 207 from 3:30–4:00p beginning in October.

First Steps in music is a class for families to enjoy music with their child including simple songs, games, and prayers for 2- and 3- year olds. Classes are on Sunday afternoons.

DURING THE YEAR

IT'S ELEMENTARY

It's Elementary is an after school faith formation program for children in 1st–5th grade. Children come from almost 10 different elementary schools in the area on Wednesdays to encounter God and develop abiding friendships with one another and volunteers. It's Elementary is almost like a mini-Bible school encouraging children to grow in faith through exploring Bible stories, recreation, crafts and games, service learning projects and worship. Leaders are volunteers from the congregation and the Associate Pastor for Children.

It's Elementary meets on Wednesdays from 2:30–4:30. Children arrive from 2:30–3:00 and programs begin at 3:00. There is also a later start group for children with varied schedules. Email Lauren Slingerland for more information.

BASKETBALL

Athletics are a valuable way for children to encounter God through recreation and connect with the community of faith. Church basketball is open to children and youth ages K5–12th grade. The church league is active from the beginning of November until the first of February. Practices vary during the week and games are held on Saturday mornings and Monday evenings. You must be a member to coach a WPC Team.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL (VBS)

Vacation Bible School is usually held the first full week of June. Children in K5–5th grade are invited to participate and youth are invited to volunteer as helpers. Volunteers from the congregation are the foundation of Bible School and there is a role for everyone! Childcare is provided for children of volunteers during the week.

The theme of Bible School is usually announced in the winter and registration opens for members in the spring. Members are given priority for registration and space is limited. Vacation Bible School runs Monday–Friday with a fun day on Friday including bounce houses and special treats. Each day is filled with worship, stories, crafts, recreation, and service learning projects to connect with our community.

BINGO NIGHT!

At the end of July, we celebrate the summer with a special BINGO night and hot dog supper. This event has come to be a joyful intergenerational event for the congregation and is especially great for families and children. We look forward to seeing you there!
